Behaviour Code of conduct - children

This code of behaviour is there to make sure everyone who takes part in **Apple Tree Farm Services CIC's** activities knows what is expected of them and feels safe, respected and valued.



This policy should be read in conjunction with our behaviour policy for staff.

We expect people who take part in our services to display appropriate behaviour at all times. This includes behaviour that takes place outside our organisation and behaviour that takes place online.

This code of behaviour aims to:

- identify acceptable and unacceptable behaviour
- encourage cooperation, honesty, fairness and respect
- create an environment where your self-esteem, self-respect and self-confidence will grow
- encourage you to recognise and respect the rights of yourself and others
- know what behaviour you can expect from Apple Tree Farm staff (you can ask to see a copy of the behaviour code for staff)

It is important that everyone at Apple Tree Farm Services feels safe and valued. When on the farm, all staff, children and property should be treated with respect and although we understand that children can lose their tempers, we cannot accept aggressive or violent behaviour.

At Apple Tree Farm:

- If you are upset talk to an adult you trust. We will listen
- If you need time out from an activity, let us know and we will support you
- If you are angry, it is better to walk away than hit something or someone, but let us know where you are, and stay within the farm
- If you think you can't do the activity, tell one of the adults
- Hurting other people is never OK

This policy must be reviewed every three years, or sooner if deemed necessary, to ensure it is still fit for purpose.
